- Promote recognistion of volunteers by raising awareness of and encouraging nominations for all Girlguiding awards, particularly for those who are aged 18-30
- Ensure that all nominations remain confidential until awards are presented
- Ensure that all personal information and data is handled securely, with consideration for GDPR
